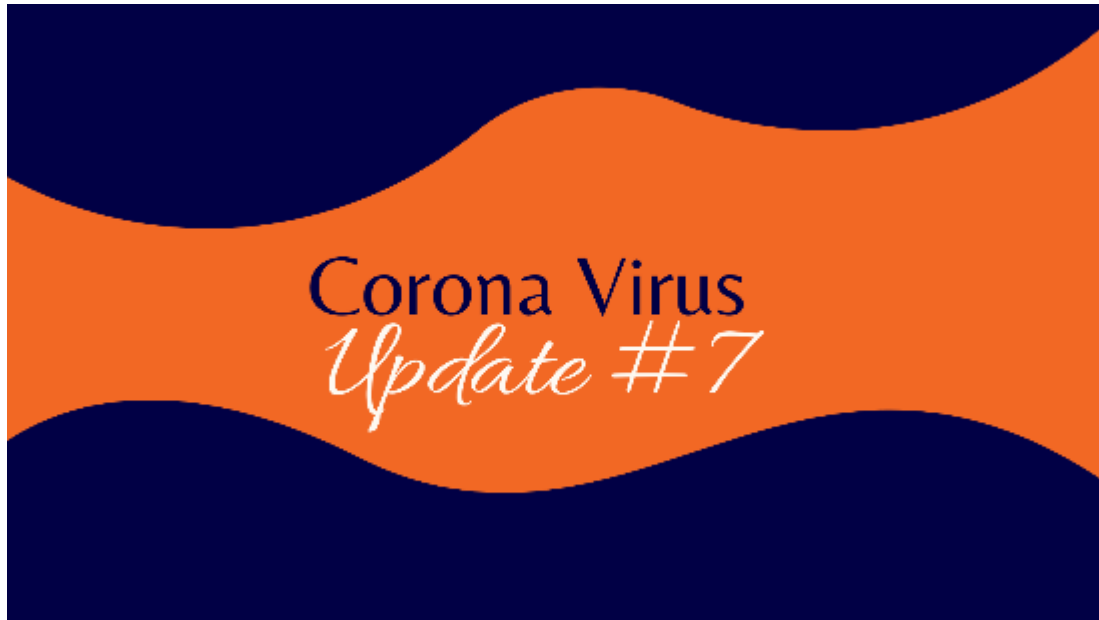

It is the recommendation from Toronto Public Health, to keep a social distance of 6 feet / 2 metres with all in-person interactions. Greet others with a wave, a bow or a nod. Handshakes or hugs are not recommended. After your interaction, wash your hands with soap and water for at least 15 seconds, or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.

Do you have all the necessary personal protection equipment (PPE) and sanitary products you need?

The Union wants to make sure that all essential workers who are critical to the University's operations are protected, including maintaining the appropriate social distance and have access to the necessary personal protection equipment they need in order to safely do their job. This includes masks, disposable gloves, sanitary wipes as well as hand sanitizers. Members are encouraged to bring concerns to your manager and suggestions of changes that would make your work area safer.
